CommunityHealth seeks to hire a full-time (37.5 hours/week) Associate Director of Development and Communications. Under the supervision of the Chief Executive Officer, the Associate Director of Development and Communications is a key role in advancing the visibility and philanthropic strength of CommunityHealth. This position supports the organization's fundraising goals, leads strategic communications efforts, and helps shape the organization's public voice and presence.

Responsibilities

Fundraising and Development:

- Lead the implementation of a comprehensive fundraising plan focused on individuals, foundations, corporations, and institutions
- Cultivate and steward donors through consistent communication, engagement opportunities, and personalized relationship-building
- Lead the identification of new funding opportunities and support grant proposal development and reporting
- Partner with the CEO and Board members to strategize donor materials, coordinate outreach, and support major gift strategies
- Lead planning and execution of fundraising events including sponsorship outreach and stewardship activities
- Track progress toward revenue goals and contribute to donor database management and reporting

Communications and Public Relations:

- Lead the team in the development of communications materials including newsletters, event collateral, annual reports, and digital content
- Develop and execute strategies to increase public understanding and visibility of CommunityHealth's mission, vision, and services
- Maintain and grow the organization's online presence including website content and social media engagement

- Lead the team in media relations, storytelling, and brand positioning to build trust and awareness
- Ensure consistent and compelling messaging across all communication platforms and audiences

Management:

- Supervise and lead the development department team to ensure optimal performance
- Lead the team in preparation of the department program budget and organization revenue budget.
- Ensure accurate development of monthly forecasts and reports for internal and external partners

Qualifications

- General experience in all aspects of nonprofit fundraising or similar role
- Experience with major donor fundraising required
- Five to seven years of strong leadership abilities
- Proficient with Microsoft Office Suite or related software required
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
