The Opportunity

CommunityHealth seeks to hire a part-time Care Management Associate. Under the supervision of the Care Coordination Manager, the Care Management Associate (CMA) will submit referrals to partner hospitals, schedule patients for referral appointments, follow-up with patients regarding referrals and diagnostic results, and review patient charts to identify quality management care gaps.

Responsibilities

- Contact patients to advise of lab test results and necessary follow-up action, as directed by clinician
- Review patient charts to identify care gaps
- Submit referrals to partner hospitals for consultation/diagnostic testing
- Follow up with patients to ensure attendance of specialty and diagnostic appointments
- Schedule and prepare patients for onsite procedures and specialty diagnostic testing
- Conduct diagnostic tests, including retinal camera exams and spirometry
- Clean and maintain equipment and supplies used for onsite specialty diagnostic testing
- Triage patient phone calls by assessing needs and directing to appropriate staff

Qualifications

- Bilingual (Polish/English) required
- One year of experience in a health care setting preferred
- Part-time position with flexible hours (approx. 20 hours per week)
- Excellent communication and follow-through skills
- Excellent computer skills (familiarity with Microsoft Word, Excel, and electronic health records system)
- Must be a self-starter and able to work autonomously
- Must be flexible and have the ability to manage multiple priority projects
