The Opportunity

CommunityHealth seeks to hire a Contract Pharmacist. Under the supervision of Director of Pharmacy, the Contract Pharmacist will be responsible for filling patient prescriptions in addition to ensuring policies and protocols are followed.

Responsibilities

- Processes prescriptions: Enters/verifies/updates patient and provider information in QS/1 (including patient eligibility), verifies that the prescription information is complete and accurate, performs medication reconciliation, answers provider, volunteer, staff and patient questions, generates labels for medications and health care related items, fills patient prescriptions, verifies filled prescriptions, files prescriptions and other relevant documents as appropriate.
- Works with patients, volunteers, and staff to ensure that patients access appropriate medications.
- Works with appropriate staff to ensure pharmacy is functioning at maximum capacity, including daily workflow assignments to other staff and volunteer technicians.
- Works in collaboration with CommunityHealth health care providers (i.e. makes recommendations on medications, answers medication related questions).
- Provides education and counseling to patients as needed.
- Works with pharmacy staff and volunteers to ensure that the pharmacy is in compliance with all health center policies and procedures.

- Current Illinois Pharmacist License
- Bilingual Spanish or Polish a plus
- Interest in and comfort working with diverse patient population
- Commitment to the CommunityHealth mission, model of service delivery and core values
