### The Opportunity

CommunityHealth seeks to hire a full time Community Outreach Worker. Under the supervision of the Health Education Manager, the Community Outreach Worker will represent CommunityHealth in community events and gatherings and increase awareness of the services and programs we offer.

### Responsibilities

- Represent CommunityHealth at community outreach and education events at local community organizations to increase awareness of CommunityHealth programs and services and to promote healthy lifestyles.
- Lead educational workshops as needed in Spanish and English, both in person and using phone/video formats.
- Assist with scheduling, planning, and implementing health education events and classes.
- Conduct home visits as part of the Healthy Homes Program.
- Communicate with patients via phone, text messaging, and in person.
- Provide patients information and support in connecting to resources.
- Attend training and learning related to job position and duties

### Qualifications

- Fluency in English and Spanish both oral and written is required.
- A close understanding of the community being served.
- Ability to travel to community events and patients' homes.
- Lived experience navigating barriers to accessing healthcare services.
- Flexible disposition and growth mindset.
- Must be willing and able to commit to a flexible schedule.
- Position requires variable evening and Saturday hours.
- Ability to walk or stand for extended periods of time.
- Excellent communication skills.

- Enthusiastic self-starter who can work well both independently and in teams.
- Commitment to CommunityHealth mission, model of service delivery, and core values.
